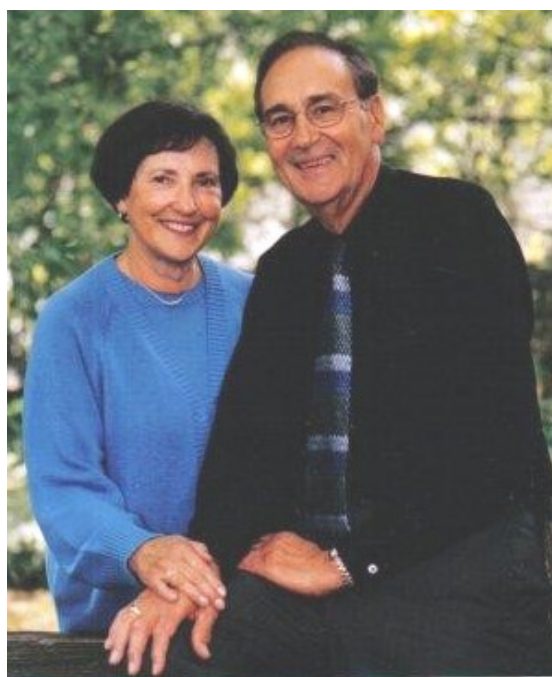

Together they agreed, and thus began the Chisholm 500+ Foundation. It was decided that alumni should be approached with the message that only earnings from funds amassed would be granted to local organizations. Ron began contacting friends and alumni of the local high school, far and wide. He and Carole made personal visits around the country. His message was that we should give something back to the community that provided us our start in life. It seemed, at the time, to be a monumental task. But he had a dream and he said "Come on board this ship with me and let's see where it goes." Thus began a voyage into an unknown, which he has captained so courageously throughout the years. Early, he encouraged many to invest and soon,

those that gave something back became INVESTORS. Soon the name was changed to the Chisholm Community Foundation and a Board of Advisors was appointed.

Interested citizens began meeting regularly and the fervor of the captain rubbed off on them and the fund began to grow. The Minnesota Community Foundation was asked to be the caretaker of the funds and by commingling the CCF account with many others, advantageous results in appreciation were

reached. Ron has loved this ship for 10 these many years. He has steered it through muddy waters, picked up hundreds of passengers and brought on shipmates who desired to "go the distance". His heart and soul have been stamped with CCF. He has lived and breathed it on a daily basis and has left no stone unturned. From the annual golf outing to the initiation of corporate partners to keeping deer hunters in beverages, he was always thinking of ways to increase the treasury. His work has paid off wondrously and the rewards are in the grants. \$500,000 has been awarded to the school district, the City and numerous other local 501c3 non-profit organizations.

At the Annual Meeting this summer (during the All Class Reunion), our captain will retire as Chairman of the CCF. What more can be said about his accomplishments? How can we say THANKS for a job well done? We can only hope that he will desire to get back on the ship at times and help in some way.

1987 to 2007—20 Years Old!

It almost sounds like an obituary, but it's really a celebration of success and rebirth for our community and schools.

Here's a look back. At the All Class Reunion in 1987, a group of us hashed and rehashed what we could do to sustain our town and schools. With Dolly Gornick's insistence that "we have to do something for Chisholm", the Foundation idea was born. No name, no direction, no money—just a whole lot of "guts."

At the Saturday evening "Grand Reunion Banquet", the idea was presented to the hundreds of people that were in attendance. By unanimous voice vote, the Chisholm Community Foundation became a reality.

To our disbelief, before Peter Santrach even left the podium, over \$1,500 was donated and we collected a \$500 check from Duane and Bette Adamic.

Today we are a success story second to none for Chisholm. As of April 2007, our corpus fund, including three family funds, totals over \$1.6 million. Since 1998, we have awarded 97 grants to our community and schools, totaling \$500,000.

We only wish that all those who were present that evening at the 1987 Reunion could be with us at our 20th Anniversary Celebration and Annual Meeting. It is our hope that you will recognize many of the projects.

It's impossible for all of you to come home for the All Class Reunion and our 20th anniversary celebration, but we hope you will continue to show your support of the CCF. We truly appreciate it!
