Within the next three years, the Chisholm Community Foundation is anticipating a number of vacancies on our Advisory Board. Below is a brief overview of the Foundation and board responsibilities.

The Advisory Board meets the second Wednesday of every month at 4:00 p.m. at the Chisholm Community Foundation office. Information to be discussed at meetings is mailed in advance, thus allowing time for review prior to meetings. Meetings usually adjourn by 5:30 p.m. Board members are also expected to participate on one or more committees, according to their areas of expertise. In addition, board members are actively involved in fundraising events, public speaking opportunities and other activities that promote the Foundation. Members may serve two three-year terms - a total of six years. It is expected that all board members are investors in the CCF.

The nominations committee continually accepts applications and nominations for the Chisholm Community Foundation Advisory Board. Due to many nominations received and limited vacancies on the board, completed applications may be kept on file for at least four years. We look forward to receiving your response.
