As we move toward 2019, we would like to reflect on our last year and the power and potential of the Chisholm Community Foundation in our lives and town. When communities and people work together, real change is created. This collaboration has fueled the CCF for 30-plus years and has created an avenue for citizens to improve and change our community. Further, this spirit of collaboration supports and sustains thriving communities and democracies.

The CCF has local donors and donors throughout the country and world. They all recall fondly the impact of the experience of growing up in Chisholm on their present lives and they all want to continue forward with our traditions.

Due to our donations and fundraisers, both past and present, the CCF awarded over \$96,000 in grants and scholarships in 2018 and has given back over \$1.2 million to various organizations in and around our community since 1998.

In 2018, our board organized several successful fundraisers. These fundraisers serve three purposes: 1) to raise money to further increase the Foundation's funds and help maintain the operating fund, 2) to create experiences for the CCF to be visible in the community and 3) to host fun community events for citizens to come together, interact, congregate and commemorate. These annual events included a burger bash, golf tournament, investors dinner and another successful Slide the City. New next year is "Dueling Pianos" which is in the planning stages and will take place sometime in September 2019.

The CCF has helped sustain, nurture and grow the community of Chisholm. We have worked together to create a fund that allows citizens to make their ideas a reality. So when a group of citizens envisions a crazy pocket park on Main Street with the goal to reinvigorate our downtown and create a public gathering space in an economy that struggles to support vibrant downtowns, it's not just a crazy idea. In Chisholm, it becomes a reality. Or when a citizen envisions bringing a music festival to town, it's not just an idea, it becomes a reality. Or when community members identify needed improvements to the wall, lakewalk, schools, main street, athletic facilities, just to name a few, they are not merely crazy ideas. In Chisholm, they become realities. Look around town and you'll see enhancements in all of these places. The CCF has been a key part in helping to make these projects, and many, many others, not just a dream, but a reality.

It is this spirit of collaboration and community that makes Chisholm unique. The CCF's ability to support our citizens in collaborating and creating real change in our community not only has built endless new projects for Chisholm from which we all benefit, but also nurtures the foundation of democracy; citizens interacting, working together and coming together to improve of our towns, states and country.

As we move toward 2019, the CCF looks forward to continuing these traditions of collaboration and community for generations to come!

Chisholm Schools are off and running in this new school year. We have had a great start to the year. Our enrollment numbers are up slightly. One big area that we are happy about is adding a Pre-Kindergarten 4-year old program. This program is an all day, four-day a week program. We are still offering a three-day, half-day program also. We have 18 little ones coming to school, learning how to do school. They are so much fun to talk to and watch as they do things like get their lunch.

Chisholm Schools offer a variety of courses and programs. For instance, our carpenter/auto shop uses curriculum from the Carpenter's Union. The students who take this course can receive hours for their journeyman in the union. We also have a great Certified Nursing Assistant Program. Students in this program can earn their CNA and be ready for a position when they graduate. We offer a wide variety of after school programming such as swimming, football and one-act play, to name a few.

The mission of the Chisholm Public School Foundation is to accomplish the donor's charitable objectives which include aiding in the development of intellectual, vocational, physical, creative, cultural and social capabilities of students within the City of Chisholm, Minnesota or its vicinity.
