When communities and people work together, real change is created. This collaboration has fueled the Chisholm Community Foundation for 36 years and has created an avenue for citizens to improve and change our community. Further, this spirit of collaboration supports and sustains thriving communities and democracies.



The CCF has local donors as well as donors throughout the country and world. They all recall fondly the impact of the experience of growing up in Chisholm on their present lives and they all want to continue forward with our traditions.

Due to our donations and fundraisers, both past and present, the CCF awarded over \$68,000 in grants and scholarships so far in 2023 and has given back over \$1.7 million to various organizations in and around our community since 1998.

Our board organizes several successful fundraisers. These fundraisers serve three purposes: 1) to raise money to further increase the Foundation's funds and help maintain the operating fund, 2) to create experiences for the CCF to be visible in the community and 3) to host fun community events for citizens to come together, interact, congregate and commemorate. These annual events include a burger bash, golf tournament and wine tasting.

The CCF has helped sustain, nurture and grow the community of Chisholm. We have worked together to create funds that allow citizens to make their ideas a reality. So—when a citizen envisions bringing a music festival to town, it's not just a crazy idea, it becomes a reality. Or when community members identify needed improvements to the wall, lake walk, bike path, schools, main street, or athletic facilities, just to name a few, they are not merely crazy ideas. In Chisholm, they become realities. Look around town and you'll see enhancements in all of these places The CCF has been a key part in helping to make these projects, and many, many others, not just a dream, but a reality.

It is this spirit of collaboration and community that makes Chisholm unique. The CCF's ability to support our citizens in collaborating and creating real change in our community not only has built endless new projects for Chisholm from which we all benefit, but also nurtures the foundation of democracy; citizens interacting, working together and coming together to improve of our towns, states and country.

The CCF looks forward to continuing these traditions of collaboration and community for generations to come!

In addition, we have had so many diligent and committed board members throughout the years and they deserve many thanks. Together we have made the CCF what it is today!

So where do we go from here? We need to continue to grow our funds so that we can support the many non-profit groups and initiatives in our community.

Supporting our fundraisers is a fun and easy way to help. Our golf outing is the biggest fundraiser. If you are not a golfer, please consider being a hole sponsor or donating a prize for our raffles. The wine tasting event, sponsored by Keyboard Liquor each December, is also a great way to show support. It's a fun evening with good wines and great food created by Valentini's Supper Club. Volunteers are essential to our success. Being a board member is a worthwhile use of your time and energy. One meeting a month, fundraising, and planning and participating in our events is all that is required. If you feel you are unable to do that, please consider being a volunteer at our events. Your help is always appreciated and the old adage of many hands making light work is true with the CCF.

Of course, donations directly to the CCF are always appreciated. This is can be an annual donation or a donation in memory of a friend or family member or an occasion honoring a birthday, anniversary or class reunion. These are the most common types of donations that we receive. But you may want to consider another type of planned donation.

Corporate partners are the basis of maintaining our operations fund. The operations fund pays our operating expenses so that no money from the various funds is used to support the office expenses. If you are a business owner, you may want to consider becoming a corporate partner.

A bequest to the CCF can be included in a will or trust. It could be an exact dollar amount (or a specific valuable item) or a

percentage bequest, which is a percentage of an estate left to charity. A residual bequest directs what is left (if anything) after distributions are given to charity. A contingency bequest is a charitable contribution made only if certain things happen first.

A Donor Advised Fund is another option. There is a specific dollar amount required to create a donor advised fund. There are several types. An unrestricted fund provides annual grants distributed via a grantmaking process. A field of interest fund provides annual grants distributed to specified areas of interest (i.e. "the arts"). A designated fund requires that specified organizations receive annual grants. Donors can establish a permanently endowed fund during or after their lifetime to benefit one or more of their favorite charities.

We can accept other types of donations. If this is something you may wish to consider, the St. Paul & Minnesota Foundation can help you with any questions, concerns or tax questions.


