David J. Tomassoni Bridge of Peace Memorial

Progress Continues on the Senator David J. Tomassoni Bridge of Peace Memorial

The Senator David J. Tomassoni Bridge of Peace Memorial continues to move forward as community members work to honor the late Senator’s legacy of public service, leadership, and unwavering commitment to Minnesota’s Iron Range.

Phase 1 of the memorial has been completed, marking a major milestone in the development of this meaningful tribute. The project now enters Phase 2, which includes the construction of an ADA-compliant overlook deck and the final enhancements to the memorial arch.

One of the most memorable moments in recent progress was watching John Radotich of Radotich Inc. and his family set the massive arch into place—an exciting milestone for all involved. The Radotich family generously donated both equipment and time to install the nearly 13-ton (25,546-pound) arch and columns, a feat requiring exceptional skill and dedication. The next step will involve adding illuminated lettering on both sides of the arch that reads “Senator David J. Tomassoni Bridge of Peace.” The columns will be wrapped in 12 feet of local-sourced stone, with donor recognition plaques affixed to each.

The overlook deck will be anchored by helical piers and will feature safety railings, stone-infilled seating within Gabion boxes, and memorial plaques commemorating Senator Tomassoni’s legacy. A picnic table is also planned for the space, enhancing its use as a community gathering spot.

Beyond honoring Senator Tomassoni’s decades of public service, the Bridge of Peace Memorial is envisioned as a recreational asset, offering scenic views and enhancing connectivity along the Mesabi Trail system, the future Redhead Mountain Bike Park trail extension coming into town, and the Chisholm–Longyear Lake walking and biking path.

Organizers are incredibly proud of the progress achieved to date and are deeply grateful for the many donors and volunteers who have contributed pro bono services. An additional \$50,000 is needed to complete Phase 2 and bring the full vision to life. Donations can be made through the Chisholm Community Foundation.

Senator Tomassoni dedicated over 30 years to serving the people of Minnesota. This memorial stands as a testament to his enduring spirit, ensuring his service and values continue to inspire future generations.
